

Technical Origination Manager – Nature Based Solutions

Job Location: Remote

Objectives of this role

Integrity Global Partners (IGP) is developing a global pipeline of nature-based carbon project opportunities with project developers in the Global South in which to deploy significant capital. Reporting to the Head of Projects, the Technical Origination Manager will lead the technical assessment and design of NBS projects and jurisdictional programs alongside community, government, NGO and private sector partners.

Duties and responsibilities

- Conduct early-stage assessments of project opportunities, against third-party market standards (e.g. Verra, Gold Standard, others), using GIS and remote sensing data to determine project eligibility.
- Lead IGP's technical rapid project screening production and contribute to production of Project Idea Notes (PINs) for presentation to investors.
- Determine the choice of standard and methodology for each project opportunity considering market risks and project viability and integrity.
- Engage with IGP's strategic hub partners on use of innovative technologies for project design to optimize carbon and other SDG benefits.
- Assess projects against IGP's High Integrity Framework including ensuring the most robust technical design.
- Develop high level carbon models to be used by Integrity's commercial team to assess the long-term commercial viability of projects.
- Provide technical review of feasibility studies, Project Documents (PDs), monitoring and verification reports from third parties.
- Engage regularly with global project partners to validate information.
- Travel frequently to Africa, Latin America and Asia to ground-truth data.

Required Skills and Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in environmental science or engineering with significant experience in carbon development standards and methodologies for a variety of nature-based solutions. Master's preferred.
- 5-7 years' experience doing similar technical work on nature-based carbon projects.
- Willingness to travel periodically to project sites.
- Strong commitment to developing high integrity nature-based carbon projects.
- Excellent analytical, problem-solving, and decision-making skills
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills, with the ability to build and maintain strong relationships with clients and internal stakeholders.
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively in a fast-paced, dynamic environment.
